I am writing this letter concerning the upcoming bid opening for the Re-Roof Project at the Craighead County Courthouse.

Based on Arkansas Code Annotated; Title 14 Local Government; Subtitle 2. County Government; Chapter 22 County Purchasing Procedures; 14-22-111. Awarding of Contracts; Item (c)...All bidders shall be given equal consideration under provisions of this chapter, except that when the bid represents items manufactured or grown in the county or offered for sale by business establishments having their principal place of business in the county with the quality being equal to articles offered by competitors outside the county, then the bidder shall be allowed a differential of not to exceed three percent (3%) of the purchase price in determining low bid. However, in each instance in which this bid preference is requested, the bidder must so indicate before the date and time fixed for opening the bids and thereafter furnish satisfactory proof if requested.

Jonesboro Roofing Co., Inc. is requesting consideration for the awarding of this project per the above code if the situation arises and we are not the low bidder, but our sealed bid amount is within the allowed three percent (3%) per above code, that we be awarded the contract for the re-roofing of the Craighead County Courthouse based on having preference because of our being a Craighead County business.
