Be it resolved by the Quorum Court of Craighead County, State of Arkansas a resolution entitled: Arkansas Rural Community Grant Program Assistance.

A Resolution authorizing the County Judge of Craighead County to apply for a grant on behalf of the Southridge Fire Protection District.

**WHEREAS**, the Craighead County Quorum Court has determined that Southridge Fire Protection District meets the eligibility requirements necessary to apply for a grant under the Arkansas Rural Community Grant Programs, and

**WHEREAS**, the Southridge Fire Protection District has presented plans to battery operated tools, ex. portable lights, box cutters, etc. for the Southridge Fire Protection District; and whereas, the Quorum Court of Craighead County recognizes the need for the project, concurs its importance, and supports the Southridge Fire Protection District in its efforts to proceed with the same, and


**WHEREAS**, the Southridge Fire Protection District has furnished proof that they have raised \$15,000.00 through community cash and/or in-kind donations to be applied to the project as a local match.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Quorum Court of Craighead County hereby appropriates a sum of \$15,000.00 to complete the local match money requirement for the project described herein;


