Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Craighead County, Arkansas, an Ordinance to be entitled.

An **ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE RATES OF TAXATION** to be levied against personal and real property in Craighead County for the use and benefit of the cities, towns, schools, and other entities in Craighead County for the tax year of 2023 to be collected in 2024.

ARTICLE 1. The tax rate to be levied on all taxable personal and real property in Craighead County for the use and benefit of the various cities, towns, schools, and other entities in Craighead County, Arkansas, for the tax year of 2023 to be collected in the year 2024 shall be as follows:





A RESOLUTION TO CERTIFY AND STATE THE RATE OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED BY THE CITY OF BONO, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code annotated 26-73-202 provides that the City Council of any Municipal corporation shall, on or before the time fixed by law for levying county taxes, make out and certify to the County Clerk the rate of taxation levied by said Municipal corporation on the real and personal property within such City or Town. The amount certified shall then be placed upon the tax books of the County Clerk of the County and collected in the same manner that State and County taxes are collected; and

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Bono, Arkansas, desiring to conform to the requirements of Arkansas Code Annotated 26-71-202, does hereby certify the rate of taxation to be as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BONO, ARKANSAS


SECTION 1. That the City Council does hereby certify and state that the rate of taxation to be levied by the City of Bono, Arkansas is as follows:

1. City General – 2.0 mills on each dollar of the assessed value of real property.
2. City General – 2.0 mills on each dollar of the assessed value of personal property.



WHEREAS, a majority of the electors voted in favor of the establishment of a public library, and further approved an annual levy on all real and personal property within the City for the support, operation and maintenance of the public library, specifying a rate of taxation of 1 mills on the dollar; and

WHEREAS, these questions being answered by a majority of the qualified voters the Mayor proclaimed it adopted by law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to the millage rollback computation - Arkansas Statute 84-493.2; Section 3, Act 848, the taxation will be as follows: On all real property the taxes are at the rate of 1 mills on the dollar and on all personal property, excepting household goods, the rate is 1 mills on the dollar.
