July 14, 2014 Quorum Court Meeting

11 Justices of the Peace present, Justice Barbara Weinstock and Justice Dana Watkins were absent.

Judge Ed Hill called the meeting to order.

---

Judge Hill informed the court that there was \$2.11 million in the Capitol Fund. This is enough for the purchase of a building in Lake City in which the price ranges from \$80,000 to \$85,000, leaving a little over \$1 million in the Capitol Fund.

Judge Hill then discussed the grant money the county is seeking to help pay for the disaster mitigation plan that lapsed in August. The estimated cost for the plan is \$40,000. County Judge Assistant Tony Thomas stated that due to the FEMA mandates our plan has not been approved and there is not funding to make the necessary updates. Thomas assured the Court that the county is not missing out on numerous grants.

Justice Ken Stacks inquired about health insurance. Judge Hill answered that the county was looking at different options that include self-insurance. He stated the county will request bids very soon.

Justice Mike Hawkins asked about the payouts for the elected officials. County Clerk Kade Holliday said the payouts had been finalized.

John Reeves addressed the court asking why the county was spending money to buy a new building in Lake City and when would the public know final price tag of the "Bono Pond". Judge Hill said the additional building would be for storage in a growing part of the city. It was then stated that the final cost for Bono Lake would come after the final payment was made.

Justice Josh Longmire inquired about the status of the agreement with the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission. Judge Hill said the agreement was still being examined.

Justice Terry Couch asked how much water Bono Lake was holding. Judge Hill said the water level was at six feet.

Justice Jim Bryant moved to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Justice Couch.

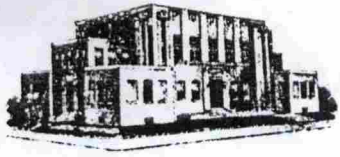
