June 10, 2019 Quorum Court Minutes

12 Justices of the Peace present. Justice Cline was absent.

Judge Day called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Judge Day reminded the Court of the new state law taking effect on July 1, 2019 stating that all public meetings must be audio recorded and held for a year. Judge Day pointed out the recorder in the middle of the table.

The first order of business was the approval of the minutes from the 5/28/19 meeting. Justice Weinstock made a motion to approve the minutes which was seconded by Justice Rogers. The motion unanimously passed. A copy of same is attached hereto as **Addendum A**.

Old Business: None to discuss.

New Business: None to discuss.

Announcements: Judge Day announced that Mrs. Vermaline Smith, the county's current County Veterans Service Officer, has decided to retire on September 1, 2019. Judge Day graciously spoke about Mrs. Smith and all the great things that she has done not only for the County but for the Veterans of Craighead County as well. He went on to state how much he, along with other members of the County, appreciate her dedication to the County and her service over the past 12 or more years. Judge Day then informed the Court that a replacement for Mrs. Smith has been hired and will begin the first week of July 2019 to receive side by side training with Mrs. Smith. The person hired to be the new County Veterans Service Officer is Colonel C. H. Overbay. Colonel Overbay has retired from the Marked Tree School District ROTC program and has also previously worked the ROTC program for the Trumann School District. Judge Day also mentioned that Colonel Overbay was responsible for the school's budget which gives him additional qualifications for this position. No further discussion was had about the matter.

Circuit Clerk Candace Edwards made an announcement that the County Assessor, Hannah Towell, had her baby on May 17, 2019 and that the family is doing great. Circuit Clerk Edwards also provided a picture for the Court to view if they felt inclined.

Members of the Court inquired about the status of Justice Cline. Judge Day informed the Court that Justice Cline's surgery was a success. Judge Day stated that he has spoken with Justice Cline daily and that Justice Cline is getting better and healing properly.

With no further discussion Justice Couch made motion to adjourn to Committee Meetings which was seconded by Justice Price.

Judge Day adjourned the meeting at 5:41 p.m.
