August 23, 2021 Quorum Court Minutes

13 Justices of the Peace were present. Barbara Weinstock was present by zoom. Also present were Lesli Penny and Marty Boyd. Wes Eddington was present by zoom.

Judge Day called the meeting to order at 5:30PM.

First order of business was approval of Quorum Court minutes from August 9, 2021. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Justice Price and seconded by Justice Cline. Judge Day took a vote and it passed unanimously.

New business:

An Appropriation Ordinance was read to amend 2021 annual budget to add Fund 1005, Coronavirus Relief Fund. A motion was made by Justice Couch, seconded by Justice Pasmore. Roll was called and passed unanimously.

An Appropriation Ordinance was read to amend 2021 annual budget to add Fund 3539, State Hazard Mitigation CR 7628/7629. A motion was made by Justice Weinstock, seconded by Justice Pasmore. Roll was called and passed unanimously.

An Appropriation Ordinance to amend 2021 annual budget to add a School Resource Officer position to the Sheriff's budget. A motion was made by Justice Couch, seconded by Justice Noel. Roll was called and passed unanimously.

Announcements:

Judge Day stated that he received an email that the Census information should be loaded at the State Treasurer's office by the end of September or October. He said what that means for us is at that point we will see the changes in our turn backs and our county taxes. He stated that he thinks the turn backs will go up and the county taxes should go down. He stated that we will just see how the numbers play out, he thinks we will be good. Judge Day also spoke of the Crisis Stabilization Unit. He stated that we have had some good results back and there have been some conversations about replacing Mid-South Health Systems. He stated that he received a phone call from the Governor's office right before the

Quorum Court meeting and they are ironing the details out. He should know something before the next meeting.
