**QUORUM COURT MINUTES

September 26, 2022, Quorum Court Minutes

13 Justices of the Peace were present. Also present were Lesli Penny, Kasey Travis, and Lesia Couch.

Meeting was called to order by Judge Day at 5:30.

Invocation was led by Pastor Nathan Liouh, Central Baptist Church.

Assembly and Pledge of Allegiance.

First order of business was the approval of Quorum Court Minutes from September 12, 2022. Motion to accept minutes as prepared was made by Justice Weinstock and seconded by Justice Pasmore. Judge Day took a vote and it passed unanimously. Road committee minutes were read by Justice Cline and Finance committee minutes were read by Justice Longmire.

There was no old business.

New business- an Appropriation Ordinance, amending the 2022 Annual Operating Budget to appropriate for Fund 1006, Dept 0116, ARPA Revenue Replacement Fund for grant monies that were made available to Craighead County by the U.S. Treasury to reimburse Fund 1000, County General, for payroll expenses and benefits that were paid from March 3, 2021, to September 8, 2022. Motion to accept was made by Justice Cline and seconded by Justice Couch to approve. With no questions or comments, Judge Day took a vote and it passed unanimously.

Announcements-Judge Day stated Craighead County had officially received the grant for the tornado shelter that we are going to add on for the community, Quorum Court chambers, and overflow courtroom. There is a meeting with architect tomorrow and we're moving forward with plans and courtroom expansions. Justice Longmire asked for the grant amount and Judge Day responded approximately \$620,000. Justice Cline asked for the location and Judge Day stated that everything is the footprint of the old jail and then back to the south in parking lot. Justice Cook asked if that was where the storm shelter would be located; and Judge Day replied yes.

With no other questions or comments, Judge Day asked for motion to adjourn. Justice Williams made motion to adjourn meeting and Justice Price seconded his motion.

Meeting was adjourned at 5:40 pm.
