Expenditures included \$7,125 for maintenance of dams, legal fees to Charles Frierson for annual fee and contracts, \$3,625, accounting \$450. Accountant's report will show other miscellaneous costs.

The Board anticipates continuing maintenance as needed, which includes one half of the 20 plus dams each year for \$450 per dam. **FILED**
