- 4. Confirm that funds are maintained in a separate bank account and not commingled with any other funds.
- 5. Review the polices and procedures that the department is utilizing for interal controls.

Findings: We found no exceptions as a result of the procedures.

We were engaged by Brookand Fire Protection District to perform this agreed-upon procedures engagement and conducted our engagement in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institue of Ceritified Public Accountants. We were not engaged to, and did not, conduct an examination or review, the objective of which would be the expression of an opinion or conclusion, respectively, on the cash basis financial information.
